General Information and Instructions

The Farmers Branch Woman's Club scholarship is available to any graduating high school senior who attends a public school in the Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD or who is a child or grandchild of a Club member. The following requirements must be met in order to be considered for a scholarship:

1. GPA of 3.0 or above.
2. A fully completed application, including required attachments. Unanswered questions could lead to disqualification as a candidate. If more space is needed to complete the application, include additional pages. Required attachments are listed at the back of the package.
3. Your fully completed application packet must be received on or before 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 6, 2025 at the following address:

4. The Farmers Branch Woman's Club scholarship covers tuition and fees only. If you have committed to a Dallas Promise college or any other college with a similar program covering all of your tuition and fees you will not qualify for our scholarship.
5. The scholarship awards presentation and luncheon will be held in May. Attendance is mandatory in order to receive your scholarship money.
6. Scholarship interviews will be held sometime in April. If you are chosen as a finalist, you will be notified of the specifics at a later date.

Essay should be typed, double-spaced with 1" margins and no more than two pages. Personal Statement (for ALL APPLICANTS): Discuss your educational field(s) of interest, academic and career goals. Include any other information you feel would be beneficial in the selection process such as life experience, work experience, leadership & citizenship attributes.

- **Attach a letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor at your high school.**
- **Attach High School Transcript reflecting your grade point average and class rank.**
- **Attach a letter of acceptance for the college/school planning to attend**
- **Attach a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report**
